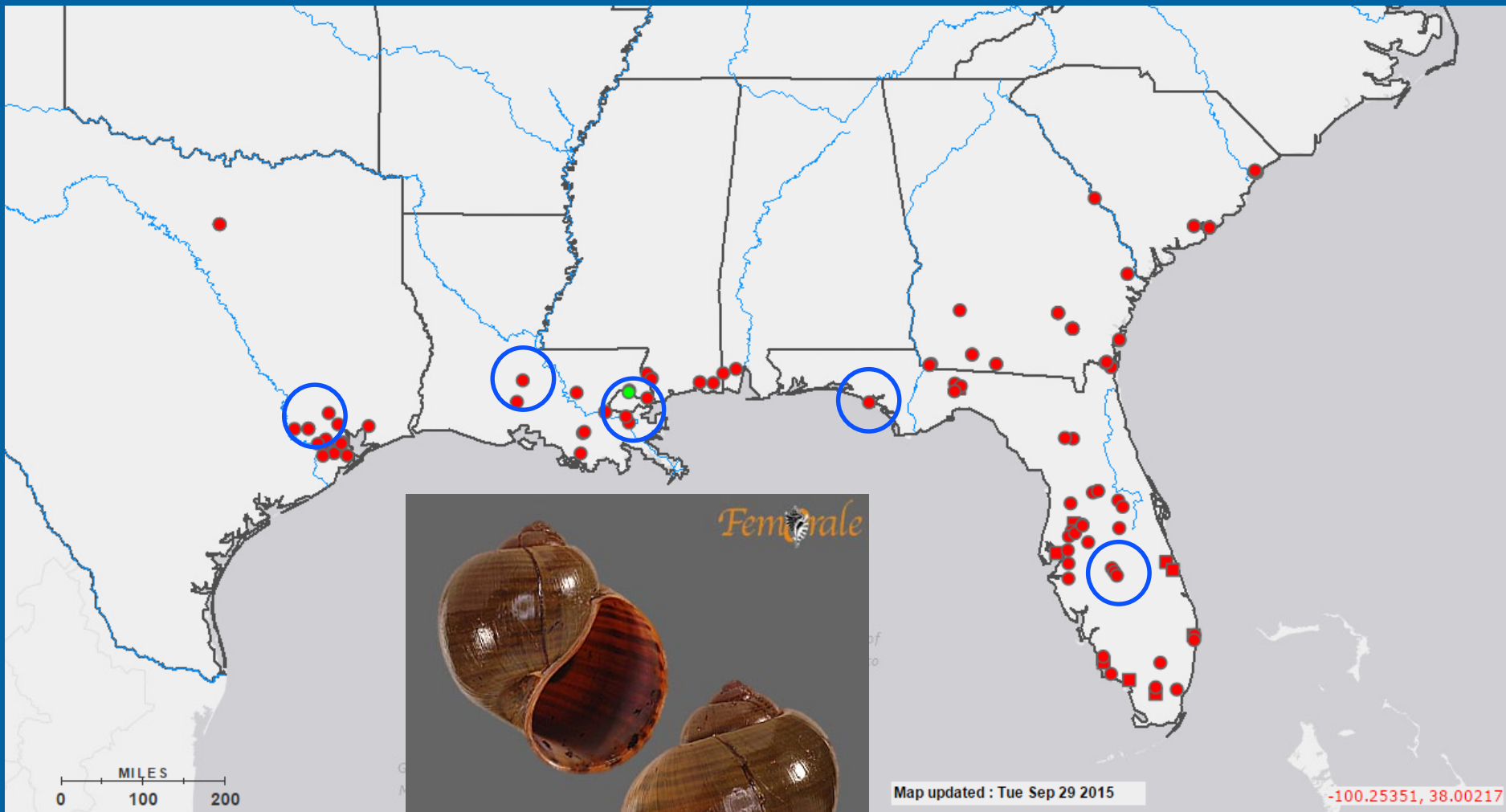

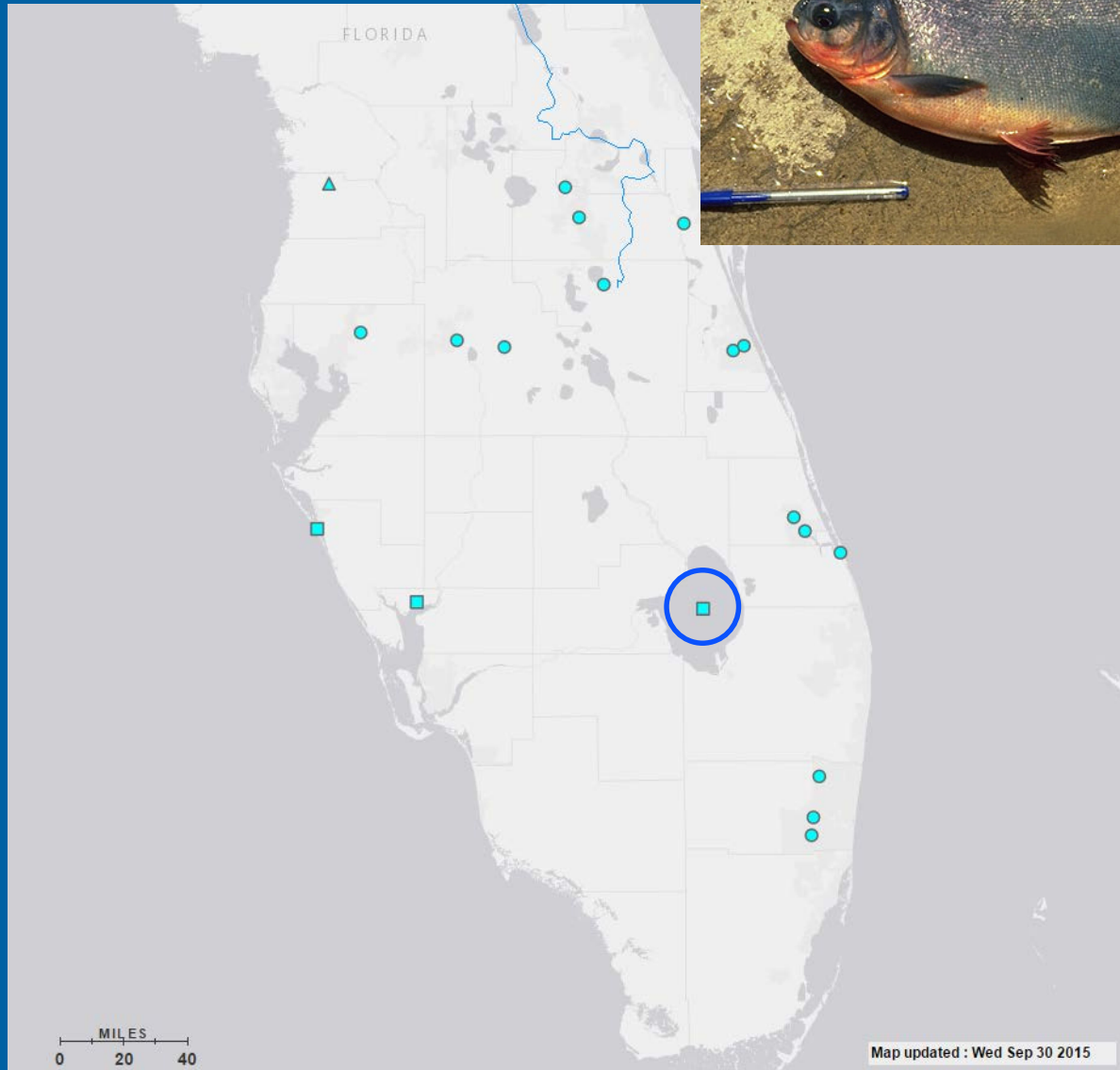

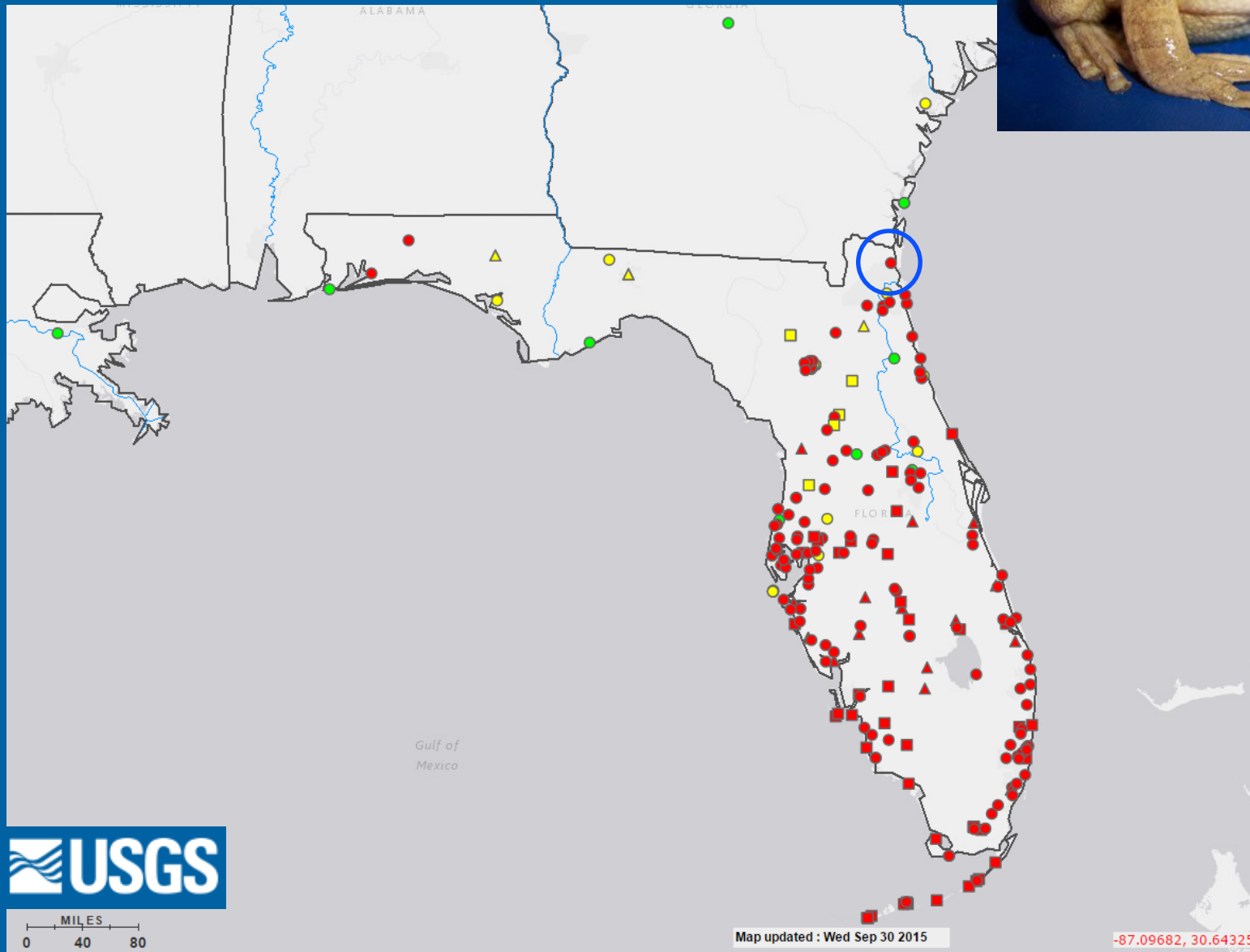

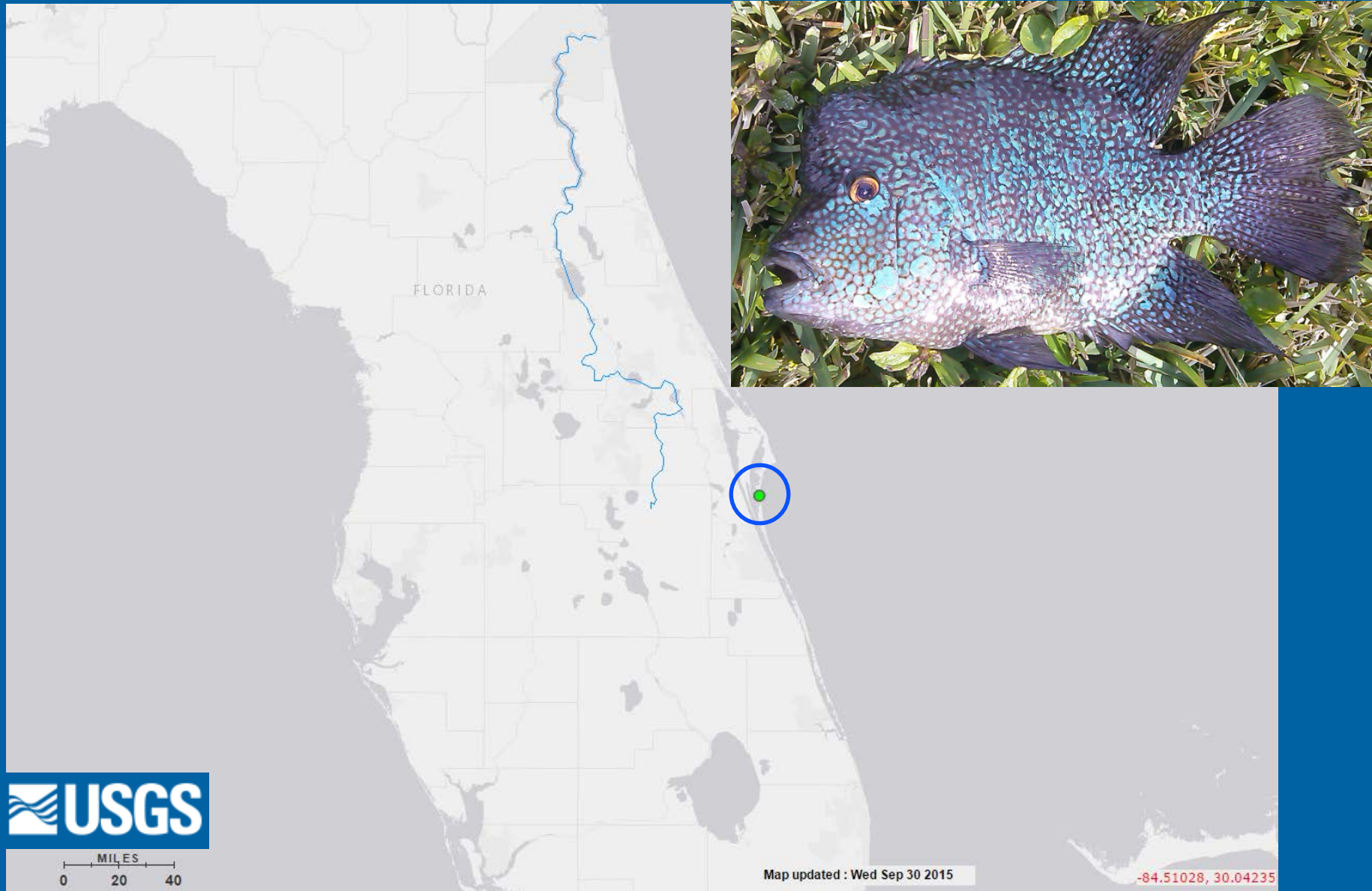
Red-bellied Pacu



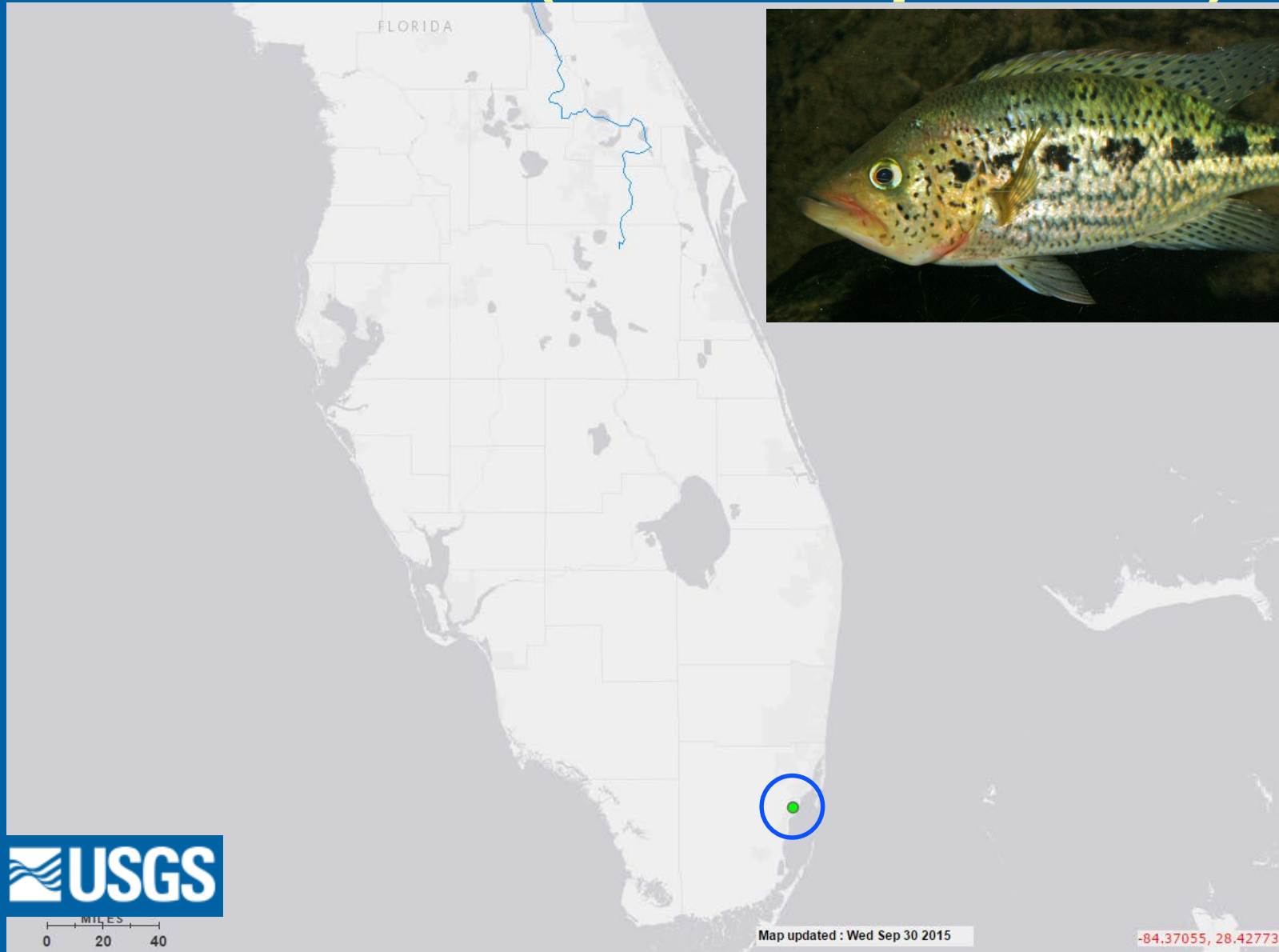
Cuban Treefrog



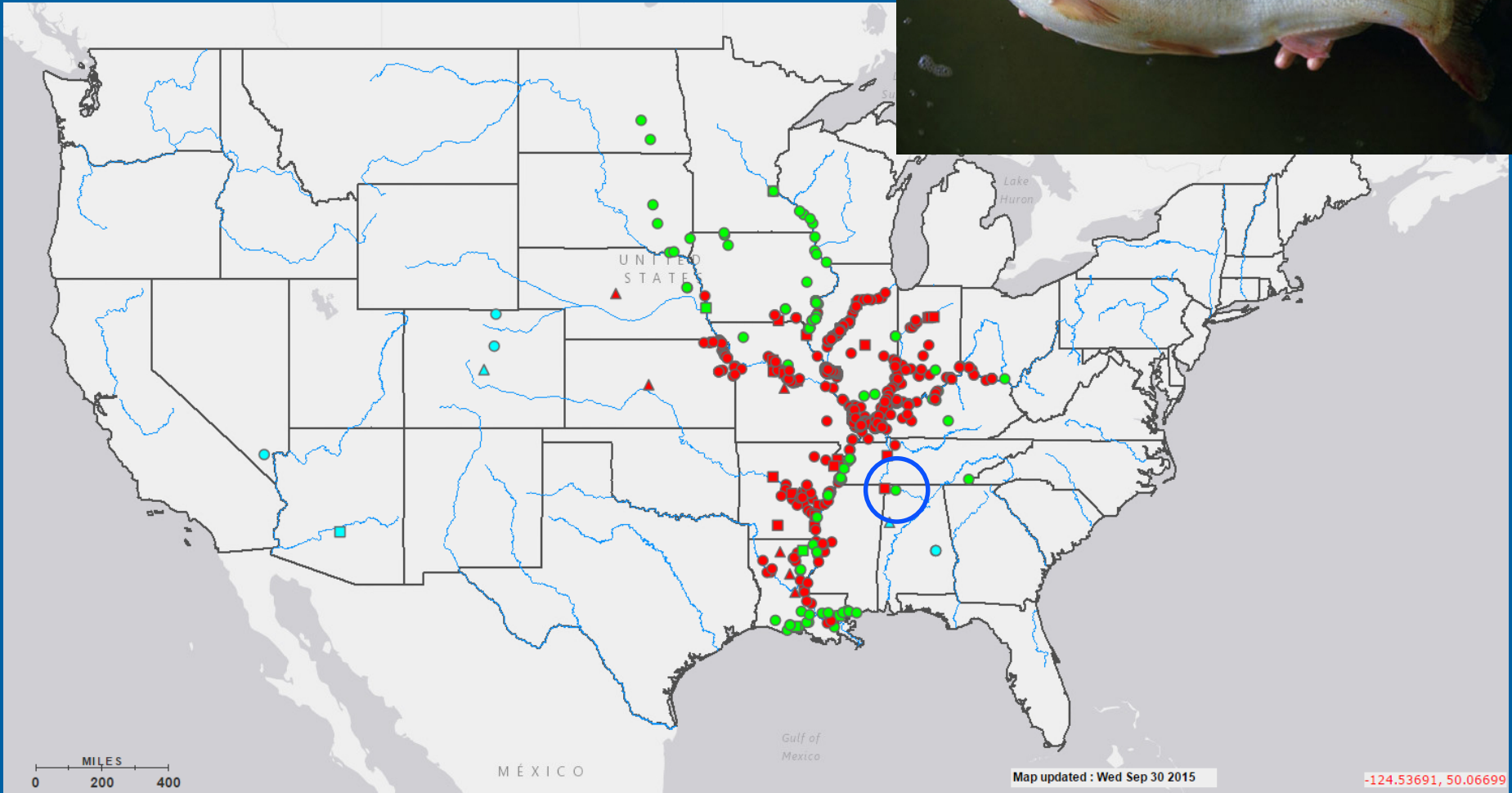
Lowland Cichlid (*Herichthys carpintis*)



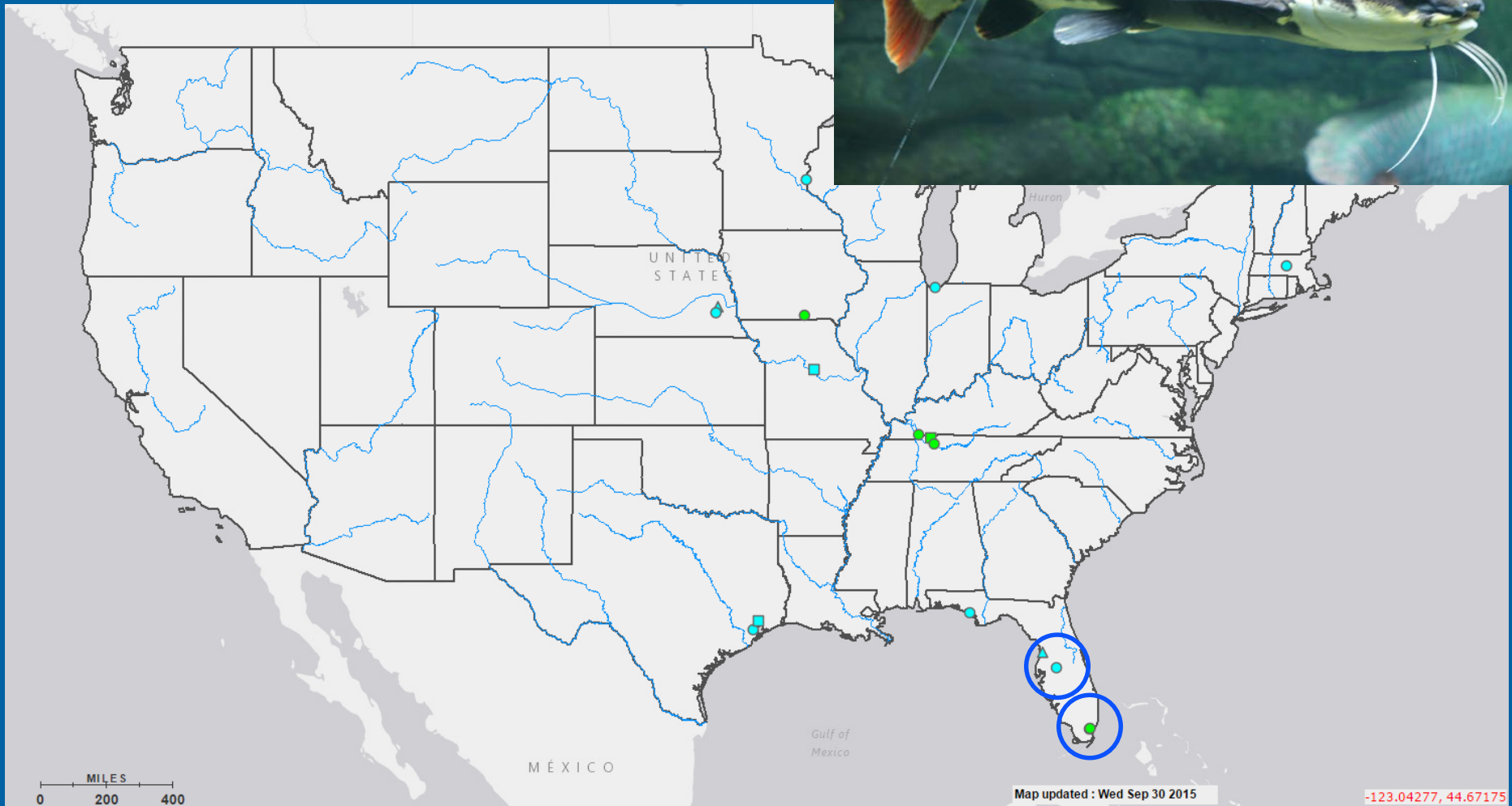
Giant Cichlid (*Petenia splendida*)

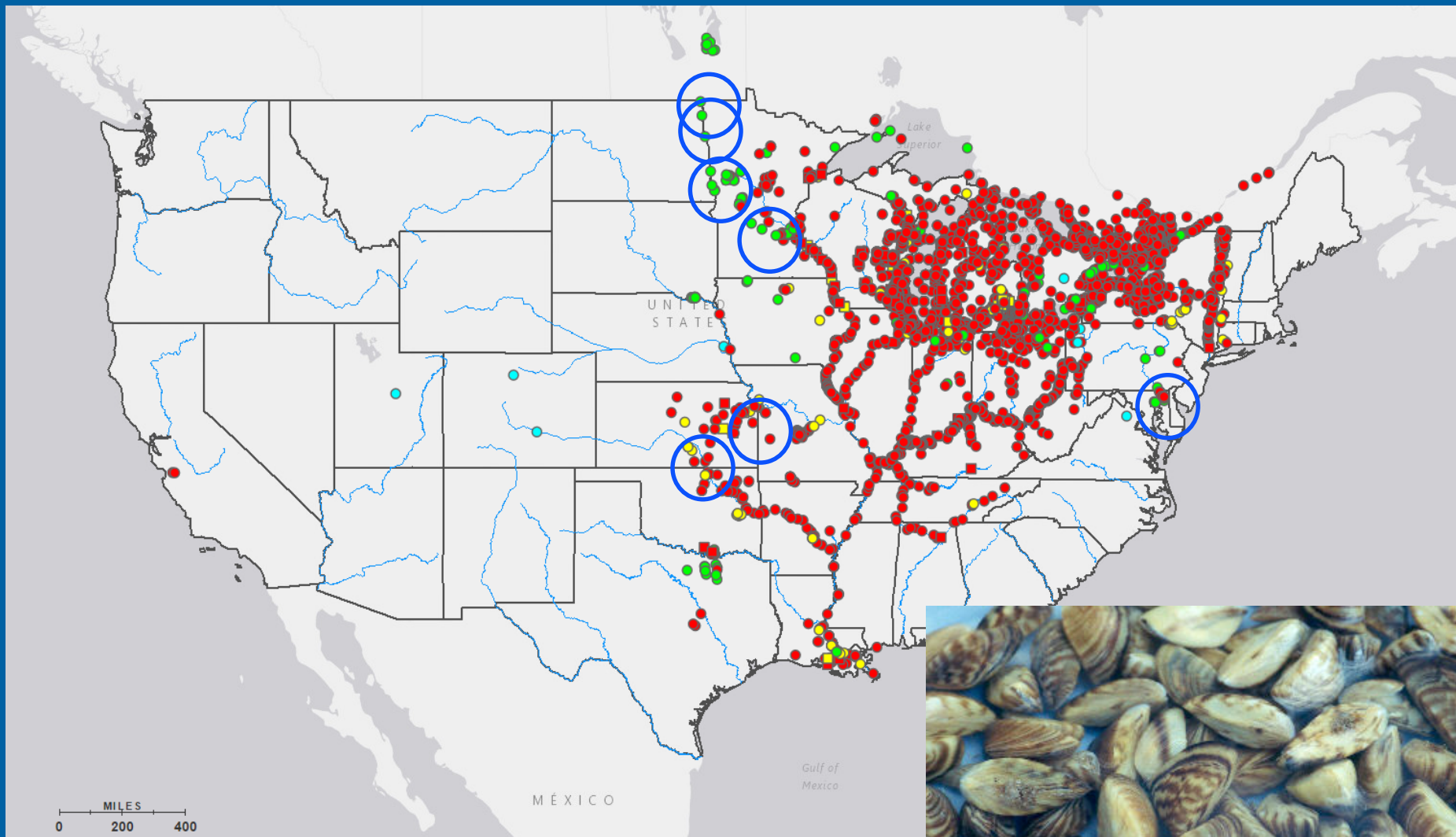


Redtail Catfish

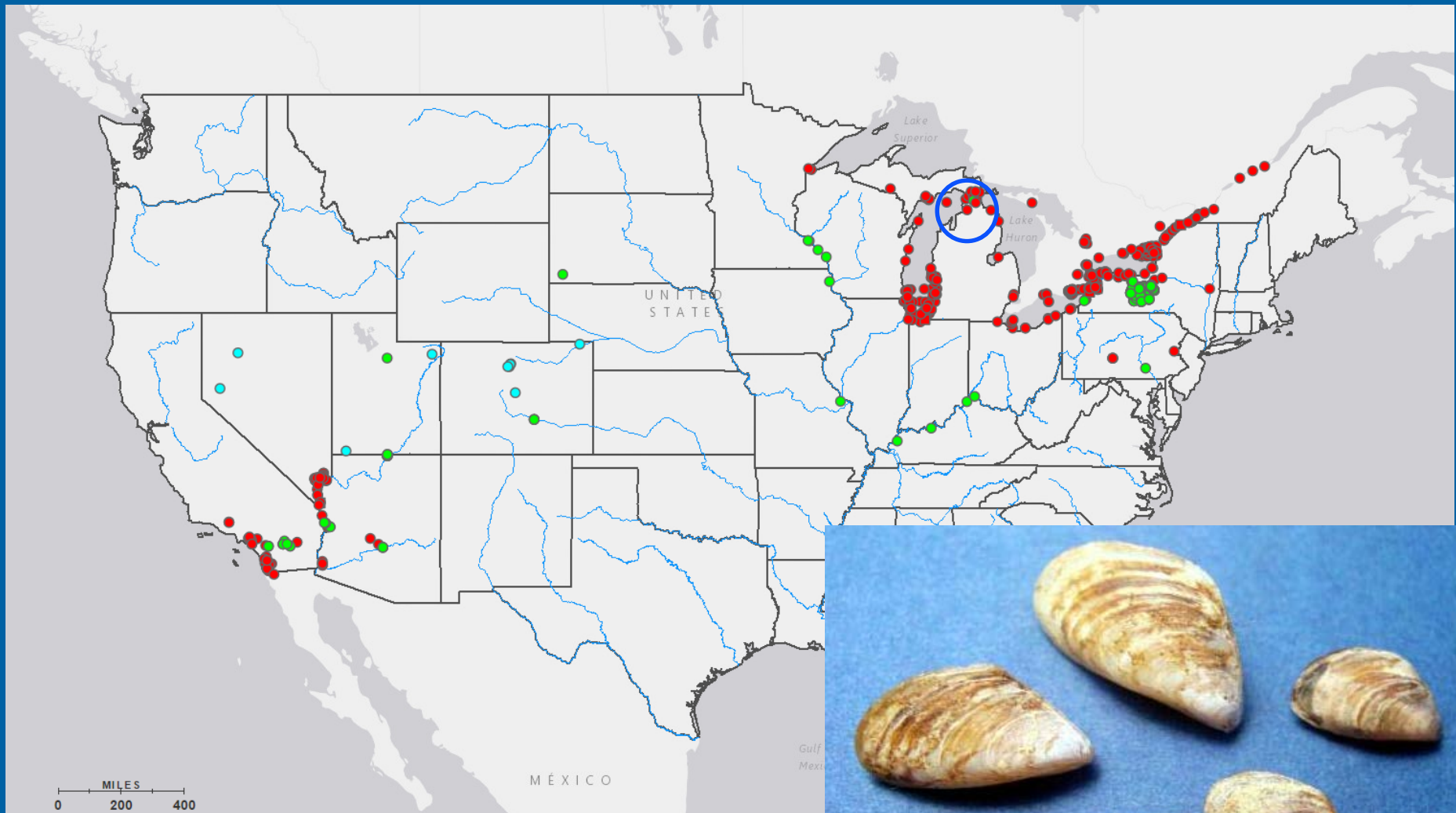

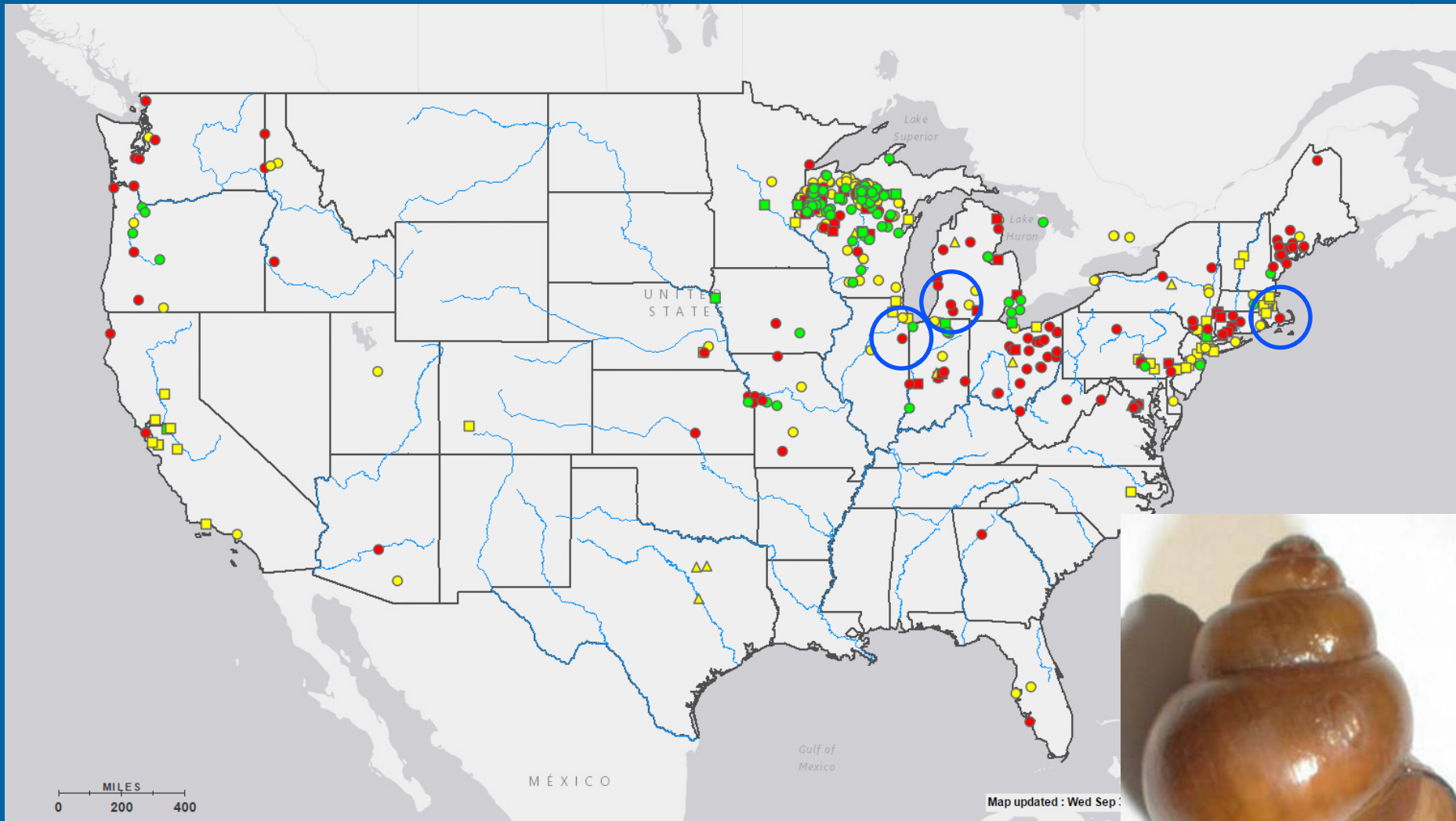
