#### **NEW DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

**Topic**: "*Territories*" are now eligible for State funding:

With territories (Puerto Rico, US Virgin Islands, etc.) now being eligible for State ANS funds, is the Panel interested in inviting these territories to join GSARP meetings? Concerns include potential funding issues to get Territory representatives to GSARP meetings, while also funding attendance of GSARP members. Benefits would be learning about what these Florida neighbors may be bringing species wise into our region along with development of new partnerships.

**ACTION ITEM**: Motion that Wes Daniel (USGS) will make contact with Territory personnel (Puerto Rico, US Virgin Islands) to gauge their interest in joining GSARP. Motion second by Pam Fuller. Discussion ensued, motion amended by Peter Kingsley-Smith to (a) require interested Territories to provide GSARP with a letter identifying their interest and investment in the Panel and (b) require GSARP to provide interested Territories with a letter identifying the expectations of Panel participation. Amended motion seconded by Wes Daniel. Motion passed.

**Topic**: Adoption of Standard Operating Procedures document:

**ACTION ITEM**: Motion for the Panel Chair to provide a Fiscal Report to the Panel on a semi-annual basis each calendar year, likely following the payment of all travel reimbursements from the preceding meeting. Motion seconded by Dennis Riecke. Motion passed.

**ACTION ITEM**: Motion to extend current Officer terms as proposed (Table 1) until the conclusion of the Fall 2024 meeting in order to synchronize the terms of the Panel Chair, Vice Chair, and Secretary, at which time a new election will occur. Motion second by Peter Kingsley-Smith. Motion passed.

**ACTION ITEM**: Motion by Peter Kingsley-Smith to accept revised SOP. Motion second by Pam Fuller. Motion passed.

**ACTION ITEM**: Motion to appoint current Panel Chair (Kingsley-Smith), Vice Chair (Phillips), Secretary (Page), and most recent immediate Past Chair still serving on the Panel (Fuller) to Steering Committee. Motion seconded and passed.

**ACTION ITEM**: Nomination period opened and closed for the three open Steering Committee Seats. Votes taken, tallied, and Monica McGarrity, James Ballard, and Wes Daniel received most votes and were therefore elected to join the Steering Committee.

#### • Next Meeting, Time, and Place

➤ Monica McGarity accepted the role of Lead Representative for next meeting which according to the pre-determined rotation through the member states would take place in Texas.

**ACTION ITEM:** Monica committed to starting to explore logistics of potential locations within Texas and after two weeks or so to initiate bi-weekly check-in calls with the steering committee to update them on the progress of identifying a time and location for the fall 2024 meeting.
